- 4. The theme **"ONE WATER"** must be reflected on the front of the poster. Soil, water, wildlife, forest, or range conservation ideas may be included.
- 5. Posters must be turned into your school (teacher) by Tuesday October 17th.
- 6. Posters will be judged on:

c. Originality
d. Universal Appeal

The Theme on the front with your designs.

A brief, catchy message; one idea that can be read in 10 seconds or less.

A slogan telling the viewers to do something and making them want to do it.

Colored and white space to get and hold attention.

Letters large, separated enough and dark enough to be easily read.
