# 2024 Conservation Education Speak-Off Rules Theme: "May The FOREST Be With You Always"

#### Rules:

- 1. Contestants must be high school students, grades 9-12, in September, prior to IASCD Conference in November.
- 2. Any prior state winner is not eligible as a contestant.
- 3. Contestants must have an interest in agriculture, resource conservation or the environment.
- 4. Schools and/or classes shall send no more than 5 students each.
- 5. Each contestant must fill out and submit an application form. This will include name, address, phone number, school, grade, age, club affiliations and a brief statement about interests or involvement in agriculture or conservation practices. - 6. The speech shall be at least three minutes and not more than five minutes, including the salutation and title. Contestants will not give their name at any time during their speech. No props or visual aids will be allowed.

- 8. There shall be three judges and a timekeeper. Money prizes will be awarded to the top 3 contestants from each district. (East Cassia and West Cassia Districts will each award: 1st place \$100, 2nd place \$75, 3rd place \$25)
- 9. The top winner from each district will be invited to compete for prizes at the Division IV Speech Contest on October 30, 202 in Cassia County.
