JOB DESCRIPTION FOR: Invasive Species Watercraft Inspector

The West Cassia Soil & Water Conservation District is seeking Watercraft Inspection Attendants. This position is seasonal and usually begins in March and ends at the end of November. Actual working dates will be available during interview process.

The objective of the watercraft inspection station is to prevent Aquatic Invasive Species such as quagga/zebra mussels and invasive weed species from invading the waterways of our State. In addition to inspecting and washing watercrafts thoroughly, attendants must engage in education and boater survey information. The station is located at Cotterell Rest Area, near Yale Road exit on I-84 northbound.

Desired applicants must be self-motivated, hard-working, outgoing, works well with others, have the physical ability to crawl under boats and trailers, have the eyesight and touch needed to detect mussels, and the hearing capability to ensure safety due to traffic and noise at the job site. Applicants must be able to pull heavy hoses and lift 25 pounds. Knowledge of local lakes and rivers, boating issues and power washers is beneficial. Positions will require extensive training and personal accountability.

Both day and night positions may be available. Shift schedules and hours vary.

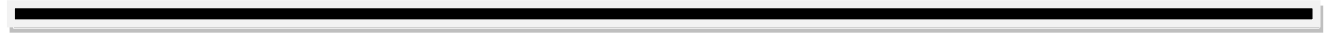
