- I. **Called Meeting to Order:** Chairman Rob Cottle called the meeting to order at 12:06 PM

VI. NEW BUSINESS

1. **Local Government Investment Pool:** Rachelle Osterhout shared information about the Local Government Investment Pool (LGIP) and how it could benefit East Cassia SWCD. Hannah Sanders made the motion to move the CD funds to a checking or savings account at DL Evans Bank when the CD matures on February 7, 2026. Once the account is set up East Cassia SWCD will request to join the LGIP. Brogan Higley seconded the motion. Motion Carried.
2. **Workshop:** Doreen McMurray passed out the workshop agenda and flyer. She asked the supervisors to share the flyer with other farmers and ranchers.
3. **Scholarship Updates:** Doreen McMurray reviewed the updated scholarship application with the board. Hannah Sanders made the motion to change the scholarship amount to read "up to \$1,000.00" and to accept the updated changes to the application. Brogan Higley seconded the motion. Motion Carried.
4. **Tree Sale:** Doreen McMurray share the 2026 Seedling Tree Sale order form with the board. She will be updating the information on the website and the order form was included in the Newsletter.
5. **Community Conservation Class to 1 Workshop:** Doreen McMurray and Rachelle Osterhout would like to change the Community Conservation Classes to 1 workshop held in the summer. East Cassia SWCD board supports the decision.
6. **Speech Contest:** Doreen McMurray made the suggestion to move speech contests to the individual districts to help encourage more involvement from the school districts. The board suggested rotating the contest each year between Raft River High School and Declo High School. It was also mentioned to share information about the scholarship and other activities the District promotes during the contest.

- High County RC&D cloud seeding donation request was denied.
- NACD dues request will be paid. The FY2026 budget amount is \$150.00.

VII. AGENCY REPORTS/ REQUESTS

1. **NRCS:** David Mabey shared the NRCS update with the East Cassia SWCD Board. The deadline for EQIP and CSP has been extended to January 15, 2026. David is anticipating the same programs and same funding however the Inflation Reduction Act money is no longer available. NRCS is rolling out a new program, Regenerative Pilot Program. There will be \$700 million to support regenerative agriculture (\$400 million to EQIP and \$300 million to CSP).

2. **ISWCC:** Carolyn Firth shared the Commission update with East Cassia SWCD. The 5-Year and Annual Plans are due March 31, 2026. The amounts for the 2nd round of match funding will be determined during the January 16, 2026 Commission Meeting. Carolyn also shared information about the CREP program.
